



Rhythmic Yoga







Rules for Rhythmic Yoga








- The performance should display atleast 10 yogasanas or more.
- Time duration for the presentation will be 150 to 180 seconds (2 to 3 minutes) for Rhythmic Yogasana.
- Participants will maintain each posture for 5 seconds during the performance.
- The transition from one posture to the next posture should be artistic and synchronized with music.
- The costume should be appropriate to the event and it should not create hindrance for the judgment of the posture and asanas.
- While performing the participant must present a theme that matches with the song/ music.
- No props are allowed. Use of any type of props will lead to disqualification of participants.
- Participants should bring the music on the USB. The USB should have only the
 music which has to be played and no additional recording at all. The labelled USB
 should be submitted to the stage manager.
- The performance should be accompanied by soft music
- Foam mat will be provided.







Folk Dance



Rules for Folk Dance





- The minimum number of participants allowed is 6 and maximum 10.
- The dance should be strictly on Indian folk songs. **Films songs** will not be allowed. Use of any will lead to disqualification of participants.
- The performance should be based on the theme for the event.
- Time duration for the presentation will be 2 to 3 minutes for the participants.
- The participants should be dressed for the event.
- Participants should bring the music on a USB. The USB should have only
 the music which has to be played and no additional recording at all. The
 labelled USB should be submitted to the stage manager.
- Judging criteria will be based on theme, creativity, costume, performance and expressions.
- Students can dress up according to the theme and carry props if needed.
 However, the same is not included in the judging criteria.





Flower and Leaf Art









Rules for Flower & Leaf Art

- Only one participant per school.
- Time duration will be for one hour.
- Participant should complete their work within the given time.
- The participants can use fresh or dry leaves and flowers.
- Artificial flowers, leaves and decorative materials are not allowed.
- A3 size paper will be provided by the organizers.
- Participants can use fevicol or fevistick. Glue gun will not be allowed.
- Assistance will not be provided.
- The art should be based on the theme of the event.
- Judging criteria will be based on creativity, neatness and presentation.





Bottle Art






Rules for Bottle Art

- Only one participant per school.
- Time duration will be for one hour.
- Participant should complete their work within the given time.
- Bottle will be provided by the organizer.
- The participants should bring their own decorative materials.
- The creativity should be based on the theme of the event.
- Assistance will not be provided.
- Judging criteria will be based on creativity, neatness and presentation.





Collage Making













- Only one participant per school.
- Participant will make a collage by creating the word MISA using pictures from the magazine.
- Participants should bring a magazine. Only one magazine will be allowed.
- Time duration will be for one hour.
- Participant should complete their work within the given time.
- Assistance will not be provided.
- A3 size chart paper will be provided by the organizers
- No other materials except glue and crayons should be used for collage.
- Participants have the liberty to decorate the background of the collage.
- The creativity should be based on the theme of the event.
- Judging criteria will be based on creativity, neatness and presentation.







Rules & Regulations

- The organizing committee reserves the rights to alter and amend the rules.
- Registration will be online through link given in the email.
- The participants should reach the venue 30 minutes before the event.
- The organizers will not be responsible for any loss or damage of valuables and materials.
- The decision of judges shall be final and binding on all the participants.
- No alternative material will be provided by the organizers.
- The participants should use Eco Friendly material for Art & Craft activities.
- The student teacher ratio expected for the event is 15 students: 1 teacher.
- All the creative art and events should be based on the theme.





Rules & Regulations contd...

- Parents/choreographers/coaches will strictly not be permitted inside the premises during the event.
- Light snacks will be provided to the students.
- Students can carry dry snacks and water bottles along.(Canteen facility is not available in the school)
- There is no parking space available in the school. Kindly make adequate arrangements.
- Dispersal of the students will be the sole responsibility of the respective school teachers accompanying them.
- All participants will be provided with participation certificates.
- Teachers cannot accompany participants in the area of competition.





Dress Code

- Participants are not allowed to wear school uniform and school
 ID card
- Participants should be dressed in a white t-shirt/shirt and blue trousers or jeans.
- Participants of Folk dance and Rhythmic Yoga may come dressed in costumes required.
