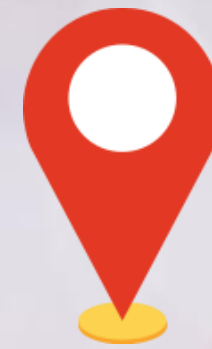

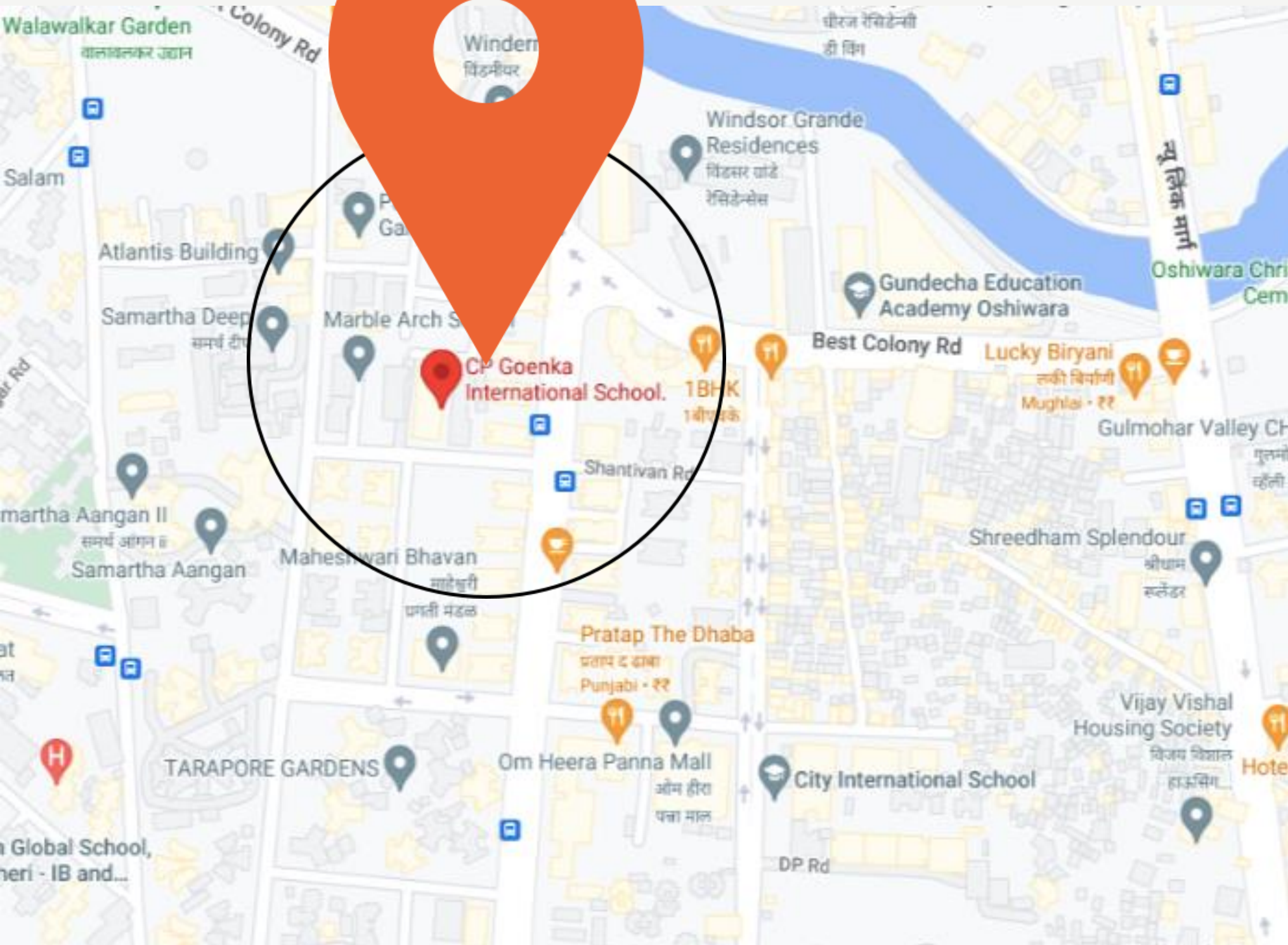

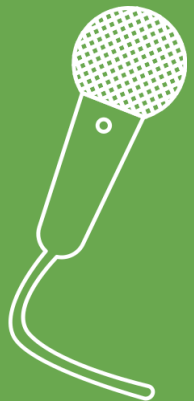


A student can participate in **any 1 competition only** as there are multiple events taking place simultaneously.

**The diversity of the Earth is seen through the diversity of human character.**

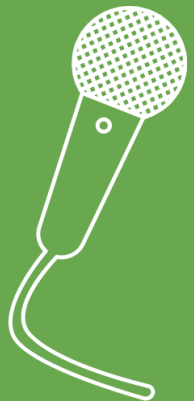
- Participants are expected to impersonate a famous personality and replicate a speech of the famous personality.

- Participants are expected to select a unique, sustainable canvas and paint a masterpiece on the canvas on the day of the competition.
- A few canvas examples - old newspaper, frames, t-shirts, used CDs, cloth, used cans, etc.
- Painting can be done using either oil pastels/acrylic paints/ water colours.
- Candidates are expected to bring their own canvas and materials like brushes, palette, water containers, a cloth for brushes.

- Pre skill required: Knowledge of Scratch Application.

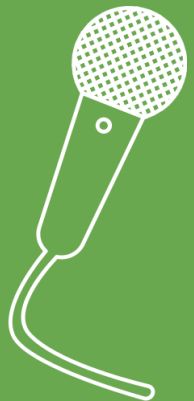

**Achievements are precious and timeless, just like the precious metal.**

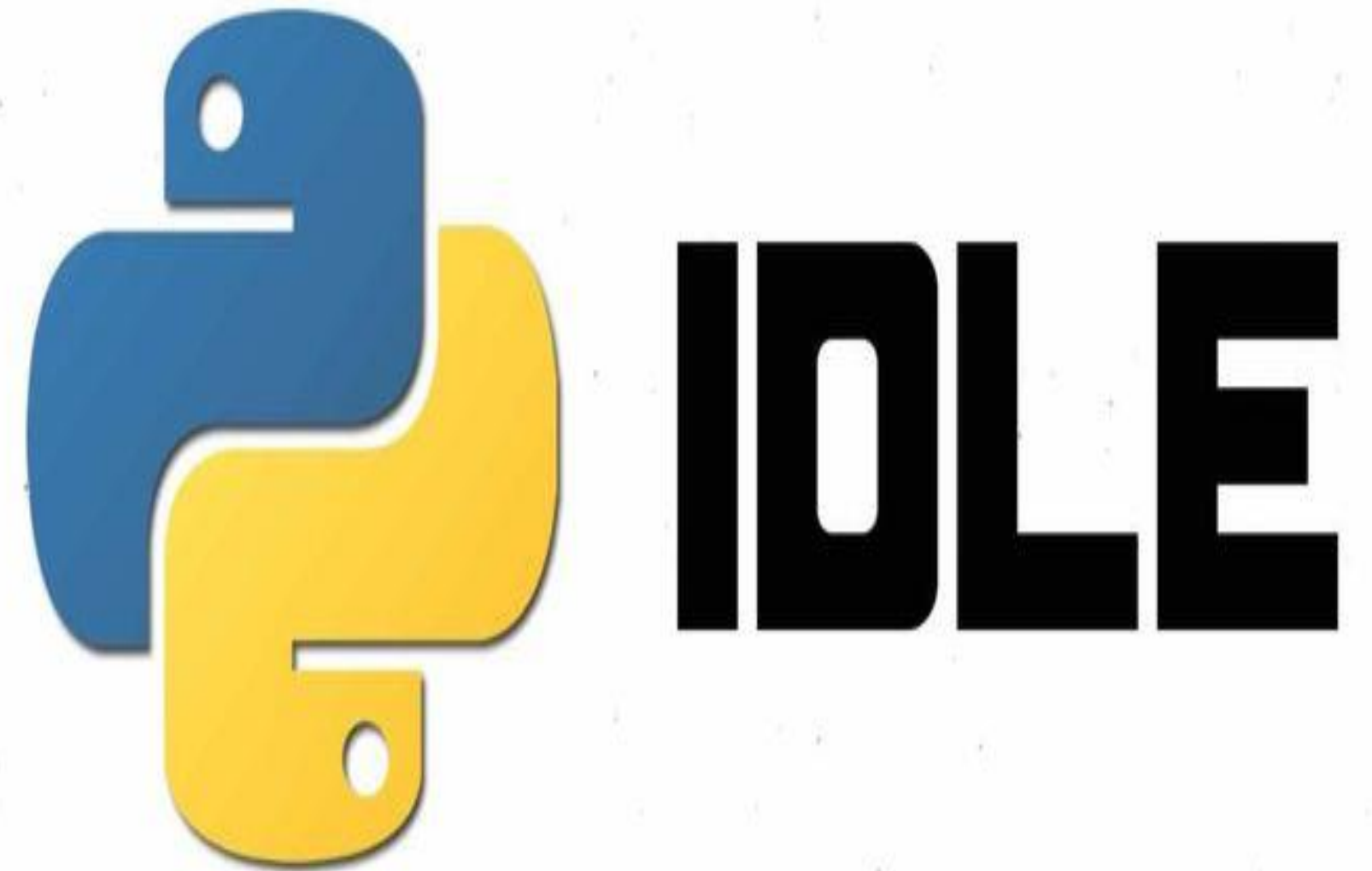
- Grades 8-10 are expected to create a graphic output on simple shapes by using the Idle Python with Turtle Graphics Software, with the use of Scratch Application.

# **TECHNOVATION COMPETITION**

Please read the DO's and DONT's of the competition before registering for both categories (Junior & Senior category)

## **Do's:**

- Participants must bring their own charged laptops with chargers.
- Participants must carry accessories like mouse, mouse pad, if needed.
- Desktop based Software must be downloaded and pre installed on the Laptop.

## **Don'ts:**

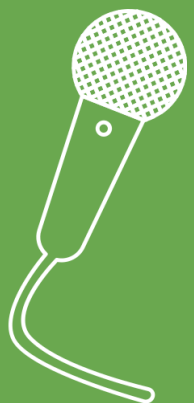
- No other software will be allowed.
- No Pre designed template to be used during the competition.
- No books/paper/reference material will be allowed during the competition.
- No access to tablets/mobile phones/earphones/storage device will be given during the competition.
- There will be no access to internet while the competition is on.

(Internet will be available only during the last 15 mins for submission)

Note: Duration of 1 hour 15 minutes is bifurcated as 15 minutes settling time + 45 minutes working time + 15 minutes submission time.

- Language of song: Any regional language.
- Participants in each group - 6 to 10 students.

- Live music by background musicians is not permitted.
- Songs used in the performance should be devoid of any profanity.

*\*Students can dress up according to the theme and carry props if needed. However, the same is not included in the judging criteria.*

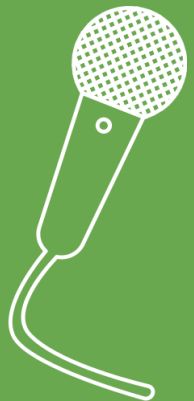

- Number of participants should be between 6 to 10 students.
- Songs used in the performance should be devoid of any profanity.
- Background music, if required can be submitted on a pen drive prior to the event.
- The group song could be in Hindi, English or any Indian regional language.
- Coaches or teachers will not be allowed to play any musical instruments *along with the students*.

*\*Students can carry musical instruments if needed. However, the same is not included in the judging criteria. No extra time will be given for setting up.*

- Number of participants should be between 6 to 10 students.
- Each group will be given maximum 7 minutes for enactment with 1 minute setting time prior to the act.
- Participants are expected to dress up according to their performance.
- Language of performance : English

Duration: 7 minutes + 1 minute setting time

- The cost of participation for individual events is Rs. 200/- per participant and Rs. 800/- per team.

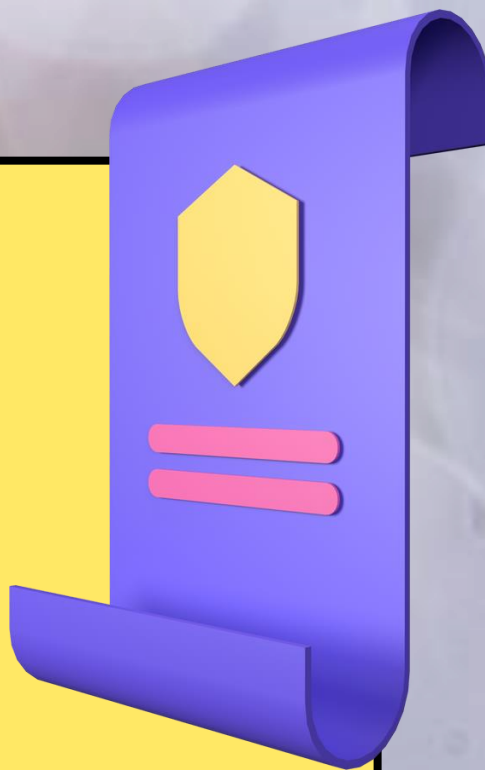
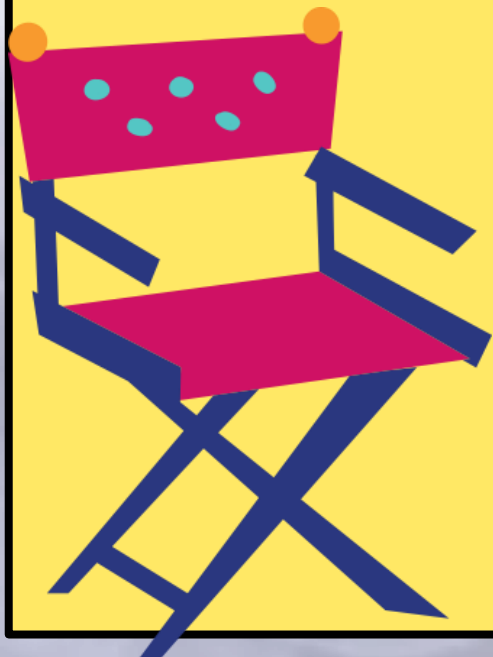
## Payment:

- Every school needs to send a single cheque only, for all the competition entries from their school. No individual payment for the competition will be accepted. No payment will be accepted online.
- Cheque is to be made in favour of 'Members of International Schools Association'.
- Payments are to be made at CP Goenka International School Oshiwara by Cheque. Cheques can be handed over to Mr. Ram at the school accounts office, in person or sent via courier to C P Goenka International School, A-21, Near Income Tax Quarters Oshiwara, Andheri (West), Mumbai - 400 053.
- Please ensure your school name and point of contact phone no. is written on the back side of the Cheque. A consolidated list of entries registered is also to be attached along with the cheque.
- Receipt for the payment will be provided on the day of the event.
- Post submitting the registration form, no changes will be accepted in the entries.



## Dress Code:

- Participants have to come dressed in a white t-shirt/shirt and blue jeans.
- Participants of competitions such as Parichay, Actomania, Gig Glory and Boogie Paradise may come in costumes as per the act requirements.
- No school uniforms and ID cards allowed.

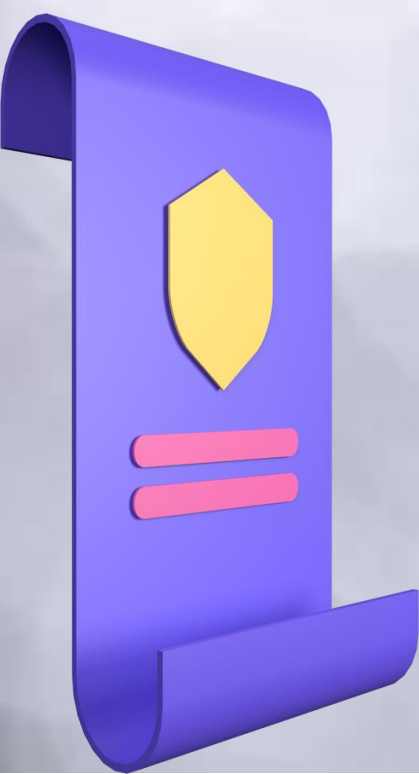




## Rules & Regulations:
