Categories

- 1. Junior Category: Grades V-VII
- 2. Senior Category: Grades VIII-X

Each school can present maximum of two projects in each category i.e. Maximum four projects per school Platforms/technologies can be adopted :

- 1. Artificial intelligence
- 2. Augmented reality
- 3. Big data analytics
- 4. Robotic assistance



- > 3 X 2 ft. Table will be provided per project.
- Maximum of 2 charts per project are allowed.
- Each school will have to carry their own stationery required to put up charts, banners, etc. for setting up their projects.
- ▶ If electrical equipments are used, schools will have to carry their own extension wires.
- > If water is required for any project, the school is expected to carry bucket, mug etc.
- If any of the participating school intends to use digital devices like a laptop, tablets etc., for their respective projects, the responsibility to make adequate arrangements shall lie with the school.
- If the project does not fit under the subscribed theme, it stands disqualified.
- Respective schools' teachers are responsible for the safety and security of their school children.
- Maximum of 4 learners working on a project with only 2 presenting it at a time. Thus maximum 16 learners and 2 teachers (1 for each category) are allowed per school.
- Dress code for learners White shirt/top with blue denims. School uniform will not be permitted.
- Setting of projects should be done between 3pm to 5pm on Friday, January 6, 2023.
